Spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis & fill quickly. To hold a space, full payment of the camp fee is due at the time of registration. We will notify you if there is a need to place you on a waiting list.

Cancellation policy: The fee/s will become non-refundable for cancellation 14 days prior to camp start date. Any cancellation before that will receive a refund less a \$40 administration fee.

Tacoma Waldorf School reserves the right to cancel any camp due to insufficient enrollment. Should this become necessary, all fees will be refunded.
